

Tasmanian Family and Sexual Violence Service System Map

This resource provides an overview of family and sexual violence-related services, programs and pathways across Tasmania. It has been developed to support practitioners, organisations and victim-survivors to better understand and navigate Tasmania's family and sexual violence service system. It combines:

- System-level mapping information
- Operational referral pathway information
- Service access processes and indicative wait times (noting these may change)
- Regional service availability
- Service navigation considerations

The Service Map is organised across the continuum of prevention, early intervention, response, recovery and health services, with colour coding used to support navigation.

Please note that this is a live document and service information may change over time. While TFSVA will endeavour to keep the information as current as possible, the Service Map should be used as a guide only. Users are encouraged to contact individual services directly to confirm eligibility requirements, referral processes, service availability and current wait times.
